

BY-LAW NO. 947.

BEING A BY-LAW authorizing the construction of sanitary sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay as a local improvement under the provisions of The Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS D. McGillivray and Harry Carr and others have petitioned the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to construct as local improvement sanitary sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay, and the Clerk has certified that the petitions are sufficient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition in the manner hereinafer provided.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THAT Sanitary sewers be constructed on certain streets in the City of North Bay as setout in Schedule "A" hereto attached and which forms part of this By-Law as a local improvement together with all necessary private drain connections and alterations or renewals of the same to the line of the street.
- 2. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be required for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- 3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the supervision and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.
- 4. THAT the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract or contracts for the execution of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- 5. THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
- 6. THE Special assessment shall be paid in twenty equal annual instalments.
- 7. THE Debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at the rate of 5% per annum and be paid within twenty years on the instalment plan.
- 8. Any person whose property is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such property, without interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk.

at a total estimated cost of Two Thousand Two Hundred and Eighty Dollars and Seven Cents (\$2,280.07),

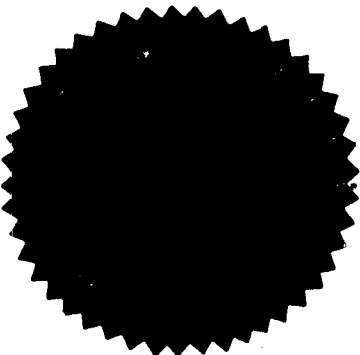
