BY-LAW NO. 2002-97

BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT THE ONE-FOOT RESERVES ON
TURNER DRIVE AS PART OF THE PUBLICLY ASSUMED ROAD
(BLOCKS 39 & 40, PLAN M-565)

WHEREAS the lands affected by this By-law were conveyed to and accepted by the City:

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2002-429 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, July 22, 2002 the Council agreed to consider a by-law to adopt the one-foot reserves on Turner Drive, being Block 39 and 40, Plan M-565 as part of the publicly assumed road.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands described as Blocks 39 and 40, Plan M-565 are assumed as part of the publicly assumed road known as Turner Drive within the City of North Bay.
2. This By-Law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of this By-Law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.
