BY-LAW NO. 2189

A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to provide for the appointment of members to the North Bay Retarded Children's Education Authority.

WHEREAS in compliance with the Schools Administration Act as amended by Chap. 105, S.O. 1964, Part XII, Section 113 it is necessary to appoint persons to the "Authority".

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That in accordance with provisions of the Schools Administration Act, of the first four members appointed by Council, one-half shall be appointed for a term of one year and one-half for a term of two years, and thereafter members shall be appointed for a term of two years.
- 2. That Mr. John W. T. Trusler and Mr. Frank Dellandrea be and are hereby appointed members of the North Bay Retarded Children's Education Authority for a term of one year, such term of office to expire on December 31st, 1965.
- 3. That Mr. Ronald G. Grant and Dr. F. A. McKinnon be and are hereby appointed members of the North Bay Retarded Children's Authority for a term of two years, such term of office to expire on December 31st, 1966.
- 4. That this by-law shall become effective on the 1st day of January, 1965.
