By-Law No. 2015-62

**Being a By-Law to Stop Up, Close and Convey
a Portion of the Cholette Street road allowance
abutting the North Bay By-Pass
in the City of North Bay**

Whereas it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the Cholette Street road allowance abutting the North Bay By-Pass be stopped up, closed and sold to the abutting owner;

And Whereas by Resolution No. 2014-428 passed on the 8th day of September, 2014, Council approved the closure of part of the Cholette Street road allowance;

And Whereas that part of the Cholette Street road allowance abutting the North Bay By-Pass is hereby declared to be surplus;

And Whereas notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

And Whereas no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, by the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

**Now, Therefore, The Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay
Hereby Enacts as Follows:**

1. That certain part of the Cholette Street road allowance abutting the North Bay By-Pass designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 36R-13772 is hereby stopped up, closed and conveyed.
2. The City shall transfer Part 1 on Reference Plan 36R-13772 to the owners of the lands abutting thereon, their successors or assigns.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.
