

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 96-68

BEING A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO ENTER INTO THAT CERTAIN AGREEMENT DATED THE 8th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1968 BETWEEN CANADIAN LONGYEAR LIMITED AND THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY RELATING TO THE RELOCATION OF A 10" C.I. WATERMAIN AND A 21" SANITARY SEWER MAIN ON PART OF THE CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS Canadian Longyear Limited has requested that The Corporation of the City of North Bay do enter into the above described Agreement;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to accede to the request of Canadian Longyear Limited and to enter into the aforesaid Agreement;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay do enter into that certain Agreement dated the 8th day of November, 1968 between Canadian Longyear Limited and The Corporation of the City of North Bay, relating to the construction and installation of a new 10" C.I. Watermain and a new 21" Sanitary Sewer Main with all necessary connections and appurtenances thereto in and under that part of the Right-of-Way of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company as shown on Plan of Survey dated October 8, 1968 made by Simpson & Taylor, Ontario Land Surveyors, upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the said Agreement.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute the aforesaid Agreement on behalf of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, and to affix thereto the Corporate Seal.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 3rd DAY OF DECEMBER, 1968.
