A By-Law to Amend By-Law No. 2007-228 (Being a By-Law to Adopt the Delegation of Powers and Duties Policy)

Whereas Council passed Resolution No. 2022-240 at its Regular Meeting of Council held on Tuesday, July 12, 2022, to amend the City of North Bay By-Law 2007-228, being a By-Law to Adopt the Delegation of Powers and Duties Policy re: grant applications and submissions for receipt of grant funding.

Now, Therefore, The Council of The Corporation of The City of North Bay Hereby Enacts as Follows:

- 1. Schedule "A" to By-law No. 2007-228 is hereby amended to include the following:
 - "28. <u>Grant Applications</u>:
 - 28.1 The Chief Administrative Officer be delegated the authority to execute grant applications, and subsequent submissions, declarations or representations required for processing the application, through the Provincial Government, the Federal Government and any other grant opportunities.
 - 29. <u>Submissions for Receipt of Grant Funding</u>:
 - 29.1 The Treasurer or the Deputy Treasurer be delegated the authority to execute subsequent submissions, declarations or representations required for the receipt of grant funds."
- 2. This By-law comes into effect upon being passed.
