BEING A BY-LAW to authorize the installation of sanitary conveniences and sewer and water connections on direction of the Honourable The Minister of Health in accordance with the Public Health Act, Chapter 306, Section 23(2), R.S.O. 1950.

WHEREAS the Honourable The Minister of Health has directed in accordance with the Public Health Act, Chapter 306, Section 23(2), R.S.O. 1950, the installation of sanitary conveniences and sewer and water connections to the properties referred to in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That sanitary conveniences and sewer and water connections be installed in the properties hereinafter described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and which forms part of this by-law, under the provisions of Chapter 306, Section 23(2), R.S.O. 1950.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of the Municipal Council to be declared by Resolution, unless the Council decides by Resolution to carry on and execute the work by day labour in which event the work shall be carried on and executed by day labour under the supervision and according to the directions and order of the Engineer of the Municipal Corporation.
- 3. That the cost of such installation in these premises including interest at a rate not exceeding six percent (6%) per annum on the deferred payments be made by the owners of the premises referred to in Schedule "A" in equal successive annual payments extending over a period of five years commencing with the year immediately following that in which the installation is made.
- 4. That such annual payments be added by the Clerk of the Municipality to the Collector's roll and be collected in like manner as municipal taxes.
- 5. That the Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction pending the completion of it.
- 6. That the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed, shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and the Debenture Principal and Debenture Interest be made payable within five years on the instalment plan.
- 7. That this By-law shall only become effective on final passing after approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board by virtue of Section 67 of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1950.
