BY-LAW NO. 999

BEING A BY-LAW to appoint three members to the Town Planning Commission for the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-Law to provide for the appointment of Two members to the Town Planning Commission for the City of North Bay to replace Messrs. J. W. Richardson, and I. D. Bedard, whose terms of office expired on the 31st day of December, 1930, and E. J. Young, (resigned) whose term would have expired on the 31st day of December 1932.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following named persons be, and are, hereby appointed members of the Town Planning Commission for the City of North Bay, viz:

A. B. MCKENZIE

DR. F. W. MCKEE

2. That E. L. Moore and A. B. McKenzie so appointed, shall retire at the end of the year 1933, and be replaced by two others to be appointed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay who shall hold office for a term of three years.

3. That Dr. F. W. McKee so appointed, shall retire at the end of the year 1932, and be replaced by one other who will hold office for a term of three years, and to be appointed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay.
