BEING a By-law to provide for the repealing of By-law No. 388, and to prohibit the running at large of dogs in the Town of North Bay, and to regulate dog tax.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to repeal By-law No. 388, and to pass a By-law to prohibit the running at large of dogs within the limits of the Town of North Bay, and to fix the tax to be paid by those keeping or harbouring any dog or bitch.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows:-

- (1) That By-law No. 388 of the Town of North Bay be and the same is hereby repealed.
- (2) No dog shall be allowed to run at large on the streets, highways, or other public places within the limits of the Town of North Bay, except as follows:-
 - (a) Unless such a dog is under the complete control of some person or persons during the period from September 15th., to June 1st., from year to year.
 - (b) Unless such a dog is under leash of some person or persons during the period from June 1st., to September 15th., both days inclusive of each year. >
- (3) That any person or persons keeping or harbouring any dog or bitch in their possession, or on their premises, shall be considered the owner or owners thereof.
- (4) That the tax for the ownership or harbouring of a dog be Two Dollars (\$2) per year.
- (5) That the tax for the ownership or harbouring of a bitch be Five Dollars (\$5) per year.
- (6) The above taxes shall be collected annually by the Collector of Taxes for the Corporation at the same time and in the same manner as other taxes.

(7) The owner of any dog, running at large contrary to this By-law, shall be liable on the first conviction to a fine of not less than One Dollar and not more than Five Dollars, with costs, and on a second conviction, to a fine of not less than Five Dollars and not more than Ten Dollars, with costs.

(8) On a second conviction being recorded against any person under this bylaw, the convicting Magistrate may have the privilege of ordering the said dog to be destroyed by the Police.

~~(9) Any dog found running at large on any highway or other public place in the said Town, and not under the control of any person, contrary to this By-law, may be destroyed by the police, at their discretion at any time, in addition to the imposition of a fine, as hereinbefore provided.~~

(10) All penalties imposed under this By-law are payable forthwith, and if not paid, may be collected by distress of the goods and chattels of the owner or guardian of the dog, for whose running at large the fine has been imposed.

This By-law shall take effect immediately on the passing thereof.

new clause

That all owners of a dog or bitch must pay the tax for same on or before the 15th day of March in each year, and procure a tag which must be attached to a collar placed around the neck of said owner's dog or bitch and that every dog or bitch found without a tag shall be impounded, and if not redeemed within 24 hours by payment of the sum of \$5, shall be destroyed or sold for the benefit of the town said corporation.

9. Any dog found running at large on any highway or other public place in the said town, and not under the control of any person, contrary to this by-law, may be destroyed by the Police at their discretion, at the expiration of forty eight (48) hours, after notice of same has appeared in Daily paper. If owner is found, in addition to the imposition of a fine hereinbefore provided, he will be required to pay cost of newspaper advertisement
