BY-LAW NUMBER 5-13 and Byland

BEING a By-law to provide for the repealing of By-law No. 388, and to prohibit the running at large of dogs in the Town of North Bay, and to regulate dog tax.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to repeal By-law No. 388, and to pass a By-law to prohibit the running at large of dogs within the limits of the Town of North Bay, and to fix the tax to be paid by those keeping or harbouring any dog or bitch.

THERFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows:-

(1) That By-law No. 388 of the Town of North Bay be and the same is herebyrepealed.

(2) No dog shall be allowed to run at large on the streets, highways, or other public places within the limits of the Town of North Bay, except as follows:-

- (a) Unless such a dog is under the complete control of
 some person or persons during the period from September
 15th., to June 1st., from year to year.
- (b) Unless such a dog is under leash of some person or persons during the period from June lst., to September 15th., both days inclusive of each year.

(3) That any person or persons keeping or harbouring any dog or bitch in their poesession, or on their premises, shall be considered the owner or owners thereof.

(4) That the tax for the ownership or harbouring of a dog
 be Two Dollars (\$2) per year.

(5) That the tax for the ownership or harbouring of a bitchbe Five Dollars (\$5) per year.

(6) The above taxes shall be collected annually by the Collector of Taxes for the Corporation at the same time and in the same manner as other taxes.

> (7) The owner of any dog, running at large contrary to $\frac{1}{\sqrt{2}}$, $\frac{1}{\sqrt{2}}$ this By-law, shall be liable on the first conviction to a fine of not less than One Dollar and not more than Five Dollars, with costs, and on a second conviction, to a fine of not less than Five Dollars and not more than Ten Dollars, with costs.

> > (8)On a second conviction being recorded against any person under this bylaw, the convicting Magistrate may have the privilege of ordering the said dog to be destroyed by the Police.

Any the found running at large on any highway or other (9) public place in the sale Term, and not under the control of any person, contrary to this By-law, may be destroyed by the police, at their discretion at any time, in addition to the imposition of a fine, as hereinbefore provided.

All penalties imposed under this By-law are payable (10)forthwith, and if not paid, may be collected by distress of the goods and chattels of the owner or guardian of the dog, for whose running at large the fine has been imposed.

This By-law shall take effect immediately on the passing thereof.
