

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 102-91

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE FRASER STREET FROM MAIN STREET TO ALGONQUIN AVENUE.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close Fraser Street from Main Street to Algonquin Avenue pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 208, Subsection 44.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Fraser Street from Main Street to Algonquin Avenue in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon until 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Wednesday 19 June 1991, for special promotion purposes.
2. That the Director of Engineering and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
3. That prior to 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 19th day of June, 1991, the Downtown Improvement Area will attend to the restoration of Fraser Street to its condition prior to the above closure.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 10TH DAY OF JUNE, 1991.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 10TH DAY OF JUNE, 1991.
