BY-LAW NO. 1584

By-Law No. 1584, being a By-Law to repeal By-Law No. 1015 and to provide for the setting of charges under agreement, for Fire Protection to certain contracting parties and outside Municipalities.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That any Municipality outside the City limits of the City of North Bay, and any other contracting party, shall be charged for the service of the Fireman, fire fighting equipment at the following rates:
- (a) That the contracting parties, being the parties of the Second Part as referred to in the agreement, shall pay the sum of \$300.00 annually which shall be in the nature of a retaining fee and which said retainer may be applied as a credit to any fire call as a result of a fire which originated within the calendar year for which such retainer was paid and at such rates as hereinafter set forth.
- (b) The sum of \$100.00 for the first hour and \$50.00 for every subsequent hour, time to be taken from the time the equipment and firemen shall leave and return to the Fire Hall.
- (c) Municipalities receiving assistance to provide oil and gasoline during the fire period, and for the return of the equipment to the Fire Hall at North Bay.
- 2. Specific arrangements are to made with the Municipality or contracting party, calling for assistance, and the Firemen and Fire Equipment are to attend fires only under specific instructions to the Fire Chief or his representatives.
- 3. All Agreements between parties are to be subject to the following conditions.
- (a) That there shall be no obligation on the City of North Bay (the party of the First Part) to dispatch its fire equipment at the request of the party of the Second Part as identified in the agreement, but shall be done only when the said fire equipment of the party of the first part is availabe, and it is convenient for it to attend.
- 4. That By-Law No. 1015 and all other By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law are hereby repealed.

This By-Law shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
