BY-LAW NO. 35-98

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE
ALTERING OF CRANBERRY ROAD IN
THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

WHEREAS Section 297 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45 authorizes the Council to pass by-laws for widening, altering or diverting any highway;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to divert Cranberry Road at Lot 32, Con. II in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS notice of this By-law has been published at least once a week for four successive weeks and the Council has heard any person who claims that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the By-law and who has applied to be heard.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That Cranberry Road in the City of North Bay is to be diverted as shown on Plan of Reference 36R-10450.
2. This by-law does not come into force and effect until a new road allowance is constructed and opened within the road allowance between the City of North Bay and the Township of North Himsworth.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 6TH DAY OF APRIL, 1998.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 20th DAY OF April, 1998.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 20th DAY OF April, 1998.
