BY-LAW NO. 1821

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to establish a Civil Defence Committee.

WHEREAS Section 387 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1950, provides that By-laws may be passed for aiding the establishment or maintenance of local Civil Defence Committees and for providing money for air-raid precaution or similar work within a Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to appoint a Civil Defence Committee for the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the persons hereinafter listed be and they are hereby appointed a Civil Defence Committee for the City of North Bay.

2. That T. E. Elliott be and hereby is appointed co-ordinator of the Civil Defence Committee of the City of North Bay.

3. That the said Civil Defence Committee be and is hereby authorized to appoint such persons as it may deem advisable to provide key personnel for the respective services.
4. That the Council shall provide in its yearly estimates such sums as may be required for the administration expenses of the Civil Defence Committee.
