BY-LAW NO. 979

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to prohibit the emptying of oil and refuse into either sanitary or storm sewers in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to prohibit the emptying of gasoline, motor oil, garage refuse or any similar or like matter into either sanitary sewer or storm sewer within the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS: -

1. THAT no person or persons shall cause or permit garage refuse, gasoline or motor oil or any like substances whatever to be emptied into any sanitary sewer or storm sewer connection within the City of North Bay.

2. ANY person violating the provisions of this By-Law shall incur a penalty of not less than \$100.00 recoverable upon summary conviction.

3. THAT this By-Law shall come into effect upon the passing thereof.
