THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 114-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF LANDS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS section 336 of The Municipal Act provides that the Council may pass by-laws for selling lands no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay transfer and sell to Elwin W. Gray and Evelyn F. Gray all of Lot 13, Plan M-179 and being Part of Parcel 2060 in the Register for Widdifield and Ferris in the City of North Bay upon the receipt of the sum of One Thousand One Hundred and Evelen Dollars (\$1,111.00).
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North Bay be and they are hereby authorized to execute that certain Transfer to Elwin W. Gray and Evelyn F. Gray dated June 24th, 1981.
- 3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.
