BY-LAW NO. 1122.

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for the borrowing of the sum of Fourteen Thousand, Seven Hundred and Seventy-two Dollars and Forty-seven cents, (\$14,772.47) upon Debentures to pay for the construction of Sanitary Sewers on certain Streets in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS pursuant to certain construction By-Laws, as set out in Schedule "B" and "C" hereto attached and which forms part of this By-Law, there has been constructed certain Sanitary Sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay, as set out in said Schedule as Local Improvements, under the provisions of the Local Improvement Act.

AND WHEREAS the total cost of the work is Fourteen Thousand, Seven Hundred and Seventy-two Dollars and Forty-seven cents, (\$14,772.47) of which Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred and Twenty-two Dollars and Twenty-one cents, (\$7,922.21) is the Corporation's portion of the cost and Six Thousand, Eight Hundred and Fifty Dollars and Twenty-six cents, (\$6,850.26) is the Owner's portion of the cost, for which a Special Assessment Roll has been duly made and certified.

AND WHEREAS the estimated lifetime of the work is Twenty-five (25) years.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to borrow the said sum of \$14,772.47 on the credit of the Corporation and to issue Debentures therefor, bearing interest at the rate of Six per cent. per annum, which is the amount of the debt intended to be created by this By-Law.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make the principal of the said debt repayable in yearly sums during the period of twenty years, of such amounts respectively that the aggregate amount payable for principal and interest in any year shall be equal as nearly as may be to the amount so payable for principal and interest in each of the other years.

AND WHEREAS it will be necessary to raise annually the sum of \$1.287.93 during the period of twenty years to pay the said yearly sums of principal and interest as they become due, of which \$690.69 is required to pay the Corporation's portion of the cost and the interest thereon, and \$597.24 is required to pay the Owner's portion of the cost and the interest thereon.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the Municipality, according to the last revised assessment roll is \$9,945.092.00.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the existing Debenture debt of the Corporation (exclusive of Local Improvement Debts, secured by Special rates or assessments) is \$1,150,225.14 and np part of the principal or interest is in arrears.

THERESORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THAT for the purpose of aforesaid there shall be borrowed on the credit of the Corporation at large, the sum of \$14,772.47 and debentures shall be issued therefor in sums of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each, bearing interest at the rate of Six per cent. per annum, and having coupons attached for the payment of the interest semi-annually.
- The Debentures shall all be dated as of the 1st day of December, 1933 and shall be payable in twenty annual instalments on the 1st day of December in each of the years 1934 to 1953 inclusive, and the respective amounts of principal and interest payable in each of such years shall be as set forth in Schedule "A" hereto annexed.

- 3. THE Debentures as to both principal and interest may be expressed in Canadian Currency and shall be payable at the Royal Bahk of Canada, in the City of North Bay.
- THE Mayor of the Corporation shall sign and issue the Debentures and the Debentures and interest coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer, and the Debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation. The signature of the Treasurer upon the coupons may be written, stamped, lithographed or engraved.
- 5. DURING twenty years, the ourrency of the Debentures, the sum of \$1,287.93 shall be raised annually for the payment of the debt and interest as follows:-

THE sum of \$690.69 shall be raised annually for the payment of the Corporation's portion of the cost, and the interest thereon, and shall be levied and raised annually by a Special rate sufficiently therefor, over and above all other rates, on all the rateable property in the Municipality, at the same time and in the same manner as other rates.

FOR the payment of the Owner's portion of the cost and the interest thereon, the Special Assessment set forth in the said Special Assessment Roll is hereby imposed upon the lands liable as therein set forth, which said Special Assessment, with a sum sufficient to cover interest thereon at the rate aforesaid, shall be payable in twenty equal annual instalments of \$597.24, Five Hundred and Ninety-seven Dollars and Twenty-four cents, each, and for that purpose the special annual rates per foot frontage set out in said Special Assessment Roll, are hereby imposed upon lots entered in the Special Assessment Roll, according to the assessed frontage thereof, over and above all other rates and taxes, and the said Special rates shall be collected annually by the Collector of Taxes for the Corporation at the same time and in the same manner as other rates.

- 6. THE Debentures may contain any clause providing for the registration thereof, authorized by any Statute relating to Municipal Debentures in force at the time of the issue thereof.
- THE amount of the loan authorized by this By-Law may be consolidated with the amount of any loans authorized by other Local Improvement By-Laws, by including the same with such other loans in a consolidating By-Law authorizing the borrowing of the aggregate thereof as one loan, and the issue of Debentures for such loan in one consecutive issue, prusuant to the provisions of the Statute in that behalf.

THIS BY-LAW shall take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 20th day of Nov. 1933.
