

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 22-68

BEING A BY-LAW GRANTING TO EDGAR GIRARD,
A RETIRED MEMBER OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY
POLICE FORCE, AN ANNUAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE
DURING HIS LIFE TO TAKE EFFECT JANUARY 1, 1968.

WHEREAS, under The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, Section 240(1), a Council may grant an annual retirement allowance to an employee during his life who has had continuous service for at least twenty years with the municipality, upon and subject to the terms and conditions as therein set forth;

AND WHEREAS, former Sergeant Edgar Girard has had more than twenty years' continuous service with the Police Department of the City of North Bay, and, by reason of injuries suffered in the course of his employment is incapable of efficiently discharging his duties;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT, commencing January 1st, 1968, the said Edgar Girard be granted an annual retirement allowance of \$1,613.28 during his life payable in monthly instalments of \$134.44.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 11TH DAY OF MARCH, 1968.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPENCOUNCIL THIS 11TH DAY OF MARCH, 1968.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 11TH DAY OF MARCH, 1968.
