BY-LAW NO. 1366

A By-Law to levy the Taxes for year 1942. and to provide for the collection thereof.

Whereas it is necessary and expedient to levy on the whole rateable property, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the City of North Bay, a sum of Money for the General Purposes of the City for the Current year, and for the purpose of defraying of the expenses of Public, Separate, Collegiate and Vocational School Education, Public Library, Direct Relief and other purposes.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purpose of providing the sum of \$592602.00 for the general purpose of the Corporation, including the amount required for Public, Separate, Collegiate and Vocational Schools, Public Library, Direct Relief and other purposes for the Current year, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 60 Mills in the Dollar upon the whole rateable property of the Public School Supporters of the City of North Bay according to the last revised Assessment Roll which rate is made up as follows:

Collegiate & Vocational School Rate	
Public School Rate	14.75 Mills
Direct Relief	2.00 Mills.

and there shall be levied and collected during the said year a rate of 66 Mills in the Dollar upon the whole rateable property of the Separate School Supporters of the City of North Bay, according to the last revised Assessment Roll, which rate is made up as follows:

Public Library Board	1.00 Mill
Collegiate & Vocational School Rate	9.00 Mills
Separate School Rate	20.75 Mills
Direct Relief	2.00 Mills

- 2. And it is hereby enacted that all taxes shall be paid into the Office of the Treasurer or the Collector of the City of North Bay
- 3. The taxes shall be payable in Six Instlaments, One Instlament of Twenty-five (25%) Per-Cent shall be payable on the 15th. day of May, 1942; 15% on the 15th. day of July, 1942; 15% on the 15th day of August 1942; 15% on the 15th day of September 1942; and 15% on the 15th day of October 1942.
- 4. A discount of 4% per annum up to the payment date will be allowed on any instalment of Taxes other than the first instalment, including local improvements paid in advance of the payment date thereof, with any previous instalment, Any instalment payments made subsequent to any payment date will be calculated as of the next following payment date.
- 5. An addition of Four per-cent shall be made to every tax or Assessment remaining unpaid after any date herein fixed for payment thereof, and being the actual amount of same then in default, provided however that if any of such taxes are paid within the dates specified below after the date herein fixed for the payment thereof, the following percentages only shall be charged and payable thereon, namely.

Taxes payable on the 15th. day of May, 1942 if paid after the 19th day of May, 1942, but on or before the 3rd dayof June 1942, 1%

> If paid on or before the 3rd day of July 1942 2% If paid on or before the 3rd day of August 1942, 3% If paid on or before the 3rd day of September 1942, 4%If paid thereafter 4%.

Taxes payable on the 15th. day of June 1942, if paid after the 18th day of June 1942 but on or before the 3rd day of

July 1942, 1%.

If paid on or before the 3rd day of August 1942 2% If paid on or before the 3rd day of September 1942 3%

If paid on or before the 3±d day of October 1942 4% If paid thereafter 4%.

Taxes payable on the 15th day of July 1942, if paid after the 18th day of July, 1942, but on or before the 3rd day of August 1942, 1%.

If paid on or before the 3rd day September 1942, 2% If paid on or before the 3rd day of October 1942 3% If paid on or before the 3rd day of November 1942 4% If paid thereafter, 4%.

Taxes payable on the 15th. day of August 1942, if paid after the 19th day of August 1942, but on or before the 3rd day of September 1942, 1%.

> If paid on or before the 3rd day of October 1942, 2% If paid on or before the 3rd day of November 1942, 3% If paid on or before the 3rd day of December 1942, 4% If paid thereafter 4%.

Taxes payable on the 15th day of September 1942, if paid after the 18th day of September 1942 but on or before the 3rd day of October 1942, 1%.

If paid on or before the 3rd day of November 1942, 2% If paid on or before the 3rd day of December 1942, 3% If paid thereafter 4%.

Taxes payable on the 15th day of October 1942, if paid after the 19th day of October, but on or before the 3rd day of November 1942, 1%.

If paid on or before the 3rd day of December, 1942 2% If paid thereafter, $4\%\,.$

- 6. In default of payment of any instalment of Taxes or any part of any instalment by the day named herein for the payment thereof, the subsequent instalment or instalments shall forthwith become payable.
- 7. The Collector's Rolls for the year 1942, shall be returned by the tax Collector to the City Treasurer under the provisions of the Statutes in that behalf.
- 8. Nothing herein done shall prevent the Tax Collector from proceeding at any time with the Collection of any rate, Tax or Assessment, or any part thereof, in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes and By-Laws governing the collection of Taxes.
- 9. The Collector of Taxes may mail or cause to be mailed to the address of the residence or place of Business of each person taxed, the notice specifying the amount of Taxes and Local Improvements. Rates Payable by such person.
