

BY-LAW NO. 1046

BEING A BY-LAW to readjust the salary of the Assessment Commissioner for the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is expedient under present conditions to readjust the salary of the Assessment Commissioner of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That paragraph 3 of By-Law 636 be and the same is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"[3) The said Assessment Commissioner herein appointed is to complete and return Assessment Roll to the City Clerk on or before the 30th of September in each year performing the statutory duties of Selector of Jurors and attending Court of Revision of the Assessment Roll."

2. The Assessment Commissioner for the City of North Bay shall be paid for his services the sum of TWO THOUSAND (\$2000.00) DOLLARS per annum payable semi-monthly.

3. That By-Law 939 and other By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

THIS BY-LAW shall go into effect March 15th, 1932.
