BY-LAW NO. 2000-82

**BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF
VOTING MACHINES, VOTING RECORDERS,
OPTICAL SCANNING VOTE TABULATORS OR
OTHER VOTING DEVICES AT ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, Section 42(1) (a) provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law authorize the use at elections of voting machines, voting recorders, optical scanning vote tabulators or other voting devices for the purposes of voting or counting votes.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That in place of using ballot papers under the said Municipal Elections Act, voting machines, voting recorders, optical scanning vote tabulators or other devices are hereby authorized to be used at all elections governed by The Municipal Elections Act.
2. That this by-law is effective for the 2000 regular municipal election and all elections thereafter.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 8TH DAY OF AUGUST, 2000.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 8TH DAY OF AUGUST, 2000.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 8TH DAY OF AUGUST, 2000.
