

BY-LAW NO. 944.

Revised 1929

BEING A BY-LAW to fix the rate of remuneration to be paid Permanent and Temporary Office Assistants employed by the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to pass a By-Law to fix the rates of remuneration to be paid Permanent and Temporary Office Assistants employed by the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:--

1. THAT Office Assistants employed by the City of North Bay shall be paid semi-monthly at the rates set forth as follows:-

- (a) Stenographers (Permanent)
 Initial monthly salary of \$60.00
 with Annual Increase in salary of \$5.00 per month until reaching a maximum of 80.00
- (b) Clerks (Permanent)
 Initial monthly salary of 60.00
 with Annual Increase of \$5.00 per month until reaching a maximum of 80.00
- (c) Stenographers (Temporary)
 A monthly rate (paid semi-monthly of 60.00
- (d) Clerks (Temporary)
 A monthly rate (paid semi-monthly of 60.00

2. THIS By-Law shall come effective October 21st, 1929.

Read a First Time in Open Council this 21st day of October 1929.

Read a Second Time in Open Council this 21st day of October 1929.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was then read a Third Time short and passed this 21st day of October 1929.
