BY-LAW NO. 33-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE A PART OF A HIGH-WAY TEMPORARILY (HOMER AVENUE).

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay has authorized the laying out and altering of the roadway from Memorial Drive south of Chippewa Creek to Queen Street north of Monk Street.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 208 (43), authorizes the Council to pass by-laws to temporarily close highways during the construction, repair or improvement of such highways.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Homer Avenue in the City of North Bay shall be closed from Memorial Drive to Bunyan Avenue from March 18, 1986 until October 31, 1986, for construction to that portion of the highway.
- 2. The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall provide and keep in repair a reasonable temporary alternative route for traffic and for all property owners who cannot obtain access to their property by reason of the closing of that part of Homer Avenue authorized herein.
- 3. The City Engineer and his duly authorized delegates shall, while a portion of Homer Avenue is so closed, erect at each end of such portion of the highway, and where an alternative route deviates therefrom, a barricade upon which an adequate warning device shall be exposed and in good working order continuously from sunset until sunrise and at such points there shall be erected a detour sign indicating the alternative route and containing a notice that the highway is closed to traffic.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 17TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1986. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH , 1986. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 17TH DAY OF MARCH , 1986.
