

BY-LAW NO. 1662

BEING A BY-LAW to enable voters who will be absent in the ordinary course of business or employment to vote at Municipal Elections before the date set for such annual Municipal Election.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Municipal Act contained in Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1950, Chapter 243, as amended by Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1952, Chapter 63, Section 111(A), the Municipal Council is authorized to pass a By-law enabling the voters who will be absent in the ordinary course of their business or employment from the Municipality on the day fixed for polling to vote at the Advance Poll.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That voters who will be absent in the ordinary course of their business or employment from the Municipality on the day fixed for polling shall be permitted to vote at any time between nine o'clock in the forenoon until five o'clock in the afternoon during the three days exclusive of Sunday immediately preceding the day for holding of a poll at the Annual Municipal Elections.
2. That the provisions of the Municipal Act as amended by Chapter 63, R.S.O. 1952, Section 111(A) shall apply to the City of North Bay.
3. That By-law No. 1176 and any other By-law inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.
