BEING a by-law to amend by-law no. 1464, a by-law regulating the Traffic on the Public Highways of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend said by-law 1464.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH Bay ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. SECTION 15 of the said by-law no. 1464 is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefore;

15 (a) PARKING NEAR HYDRANTS

No vehicle shall stand or park within ten feet of a fire hydrant.

(b) NO vehicle shall stand or park on any boulevard in the City of North Bay.

2. SECTION 40 of the said by-law no. 1464 is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefore;

40. PARKING METER PERMITS OR STICKERS:

Sections 31 to 33 of this by-law shall not apply to cars of the following, when displaying stickers or permits to be supplied on request by the City Clerk;

- (a) Medical Doctors, Members of the North Bay Medical Association.
- (b) V.O.N. and Public Health Nurses
- (c) Amputation cases
- (d) Vehicles owned by the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
- (e) Police Cars
- (f) Commercial vehicles owned by the Department of Highways, Ontario,
