THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 160-96

BEING A BY-LAW TO CHANGE THE NAME OF AND ASSIGN A NAME TO CERTAIN STREETS AND ROADS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS Council may name streets within the City of North Bay pursuant to Section 210 (111) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to change the name of a street or assign the name to a street in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS before passage of this By-Law, Notice of the same was published at least once a week for four (4) successive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS before the passage of this By-Law, the Council of the City of North Bay shall hear any person who claims that he will be adversely affected by the By-Law and applies to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the easterly 300 feet of Trout Lake Road being south and west of the North Bay By-Pass be renamed "Cassells Street".
- 2. That the portion of McKeown Avenue between Gordon Drive and the O.N.R. mainline be renamed "Connaught Avenue".
- 3. That the unnamed road allowance running easterly from Pinewood Park Drive be named "Hewitt Road".
- 4. That the road known as Boundary Road between the Township of North Himsworth and the City of North Bay be renamed Cranberry Road.
- 5. That the portion of Highway 63 between Lees Road and Anita Avenue be renamed Trout Lake Road.
- 6. This By-Law comes into force and effect upon registration of a copy of this By-Law, certified under the hand of the Clerk and the seal of The Corporation of the City of North Bay in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 3rd DAY OF February 1997.

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 3rd DAY OF February 1997.
