## BY-LAW NO. 1681

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close a Lane in the City of North Bay, said Lane being composed of a Lane at the rear of Lots 51, 52, 53, 54, 55 and 56 and bounded by King Street and McPhail Street as shown on Plan M.165 in the Office of Land Titles of the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay have been requested, and upon consideration, deem it advisable to close a Lane in the City of North Bay, being composed of a Lane at the rear of Lots 51, 52, 53, 54, 55 and 56 and bounded by King Street and McPhail Street as shown on Plan M.165 filed in the Office of Land Titles of the District of Nipissing.

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act, being R.S.O. 1950, Chapter 243, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT LANE in the City of North Bay being composed of a Lane at the rear of Lots 51, 52, 53, 54, 55 and 56 and bounded by King Street and McPhail Street as shown on Plan M.165 filed in the Office of Land Titles of the District of Nipissing and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the South East angle of Lot 50 on the West side of King Street according to the said Plan M.165; thence Southerly along the said limit of King Street, 10 feet to the North East angle of said Lot 51; thence Westerly along the Northerly limits of said Lots 51, 52, 53, 54, 55 and 56, 201 feet and 11 inches to the North West angle of said Lot 56; thence Northerly along the Easterly limit of McPhail Street, 10 feet to the South West angle of Lot 37 according to the said plan; thence Easterly in a straight line along the Southerly limit of said Lot 37 and along the Southerly limit of said Lot 37 and along the Southerly limit of said Lot 50 in all a distance of 202 feet and 1 inch more or less to the said point of commencement, IS HEREBYCLOSED AND STOPPED UP.

- 2. THAT forthwith upon this By-law taking effect the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall convey the said lane as closed and stopped up in the next preceding section to the registered owners of the lands abutting thereon for the consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) and full costs of this by-law including advertising.
- 3. THAT the Council of the Municipal Corporation in the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her solicitor, counsel or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applies to be heard.
- 4. THAT this By-law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Statutes in that behalf.
