BY-LAW NO. 126-91

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A
PORTION OF MEMORIAL DRIVE FROM THE
SOUTHERLY ENTRANCE TO THE MARINA
PARKING LOT TO REGINA STREET

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Canada Day Committee,
it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of
Memorial Drive from the southerly entrance to Regina Street,
pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302,
Sec. 208, Subsection 44.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the portion of Memorial Drive from the southerly
entrance to Regina Street, in the City of North Bay,
be and the same is hereby closed from 8:30 o'clock
in the afternoon until 10:00 o'clock in the
afternoon, on Monday, August 5, 1991, for the purpose
of a fireworks display.
2. That the Director of Engineering and Works is hereby
authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected
to carry out the said closure.
3. That prior to 11:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the
1st day of ^{August} 1991, the Director of Engineering and
Works, will attend to the restoration of the said
portion of Memorial Drive, to its condition prior
to the above closure.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 22ND DAY OF JULY
1991.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 22ND
DAY OF JULY , 1991.
