BY-LAW NO. 81-78

BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAPPING,
REMOVING AND EXTERMINATING STRAYED PIGEONS
THAT ARE CAUSING ANNOYANCE OR DAMAGE.

WHEREAS Section 363 (11) of The Municipal Act provides that Council may pass by-laws for the purpose of trapping, removing or exterminating strayed pigeons that are causing annoyance to the owner or occupant or damages to premises in the Municipality:

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council for the Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby enacts as follows:

1. In this By-law,
 - (a) "City" means The Corporation of the City of North Bay;
 - (b) "Officer" includes the Pollution Control Officer of the City and any other person designated by City Council as responsible for the enforcement of this By-law;
 - (c) "Owner" includes the person or persons shown on the assessment roll of the City as the owners and occupant of a particular premises;
 - (d) "Pigeons" includes any bird, wild or domesticated, which is of a pigeon variety;
 - (e) "Stray Pigeon" includes any pigeon which is not kept in a cage, coop or other device for enclosing and preventing the release of pigeons.
2. Upon the complaint of the owner or occupant of any premises, an Officer of the City may carry out an inspection to determine whether the pigeons complained of are causing annoyance to the complainant or are causing damages to premises occupied or owned by the complainant.
3. If, in the opinion of the Officer of the City, any strayed pigeons are causing annoyance to an owner or occupant of premises or are causing damages to such premises the Officer of the City may cause notice to be sent to the apparent owner of the pigeons, directing that the annoyance cease and that the damages be corrected within ten (10) days of the date the notice is given, failing which the pigeons may

If after expiry of the time period under the said notice, the annoyance has not ceased or the damages have not been corrected, upon the further complaint of the owner or occupant of such premises, the Officer of the City may enter upon the premises and the land and buildings complained of and trap, remove or exterminate the stray pigeons that are the subject of the complaint.
5. In carrying out his duties under this By-law, the Officer of the City may take such reasonable steps as are necessary to remove, trap or exterminate the complained of stray pigeons.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 12TH DAY OF JUNE , 1978.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 10TH DAY OF JULY , 1978.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 10TH DAY OF JULY , 1978.
