BY-LAW NO. 2167

A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to authorize the construction of an indoor swimming pool as a Centennial project.

WHEREAS in commemoration of the Centennial it is deemed expedient to erect an indoor swimming pool at an estimated cost of Two Hundred/Thousand Dollars.X\$2000,00000000 (\$230,000.00) and Thirty

AND WHEREAS authority to undertake a Centennial project is contained in The Confederation Centennial Act, being Chapter 19, S.O. 1962-63 and the Regulations thereunder.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT an indoor swimming pool complete with necessary administration office, lobby, shower, dressing, utility rooms and necessary equipment be constructed under the provisions of The Confederation Centennial Act 1962-63 being Chap. 19, S.O. 1962-63 and the Regulations thereunder at an estimated cost as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- THAT such plans and specifications as may be necessary for the calling of tenders and for the making of a contract for the execution of the work shall be made forthwith.
- 3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the supervision and according to the direction of the North Bay City Council or its architect.
- 4. THAT the Treasurer of the City of North Bay, may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction pending completion of such construction.
- 5. THAT debentures to be issued when the work is completed to pay for the cost of such work, shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and shall be made payable within ten years on the instalment plan.
- 6. THAT this by-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64(1) of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, (R.S.O. 1960, Chap. 274).


