

BY-LAW NO. 1654

BEING A BY-LAW for the Revision of Salaries in the City of North Bay.  
WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that the Salary of the Mayor of the  
City of North Bay be revised.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, PURSUANT TO  
CHAPTER 266 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ONTARIO AND AMENDMENTS THERETO,  
ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the Mayor of the Municipality of the City of North Bay be  
paid a remuneration of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) per annum,  
payable quarterly, with an additional allowance of Five Hundred Dollars  
(\$500.00) in lieu of Car Allowance and expenses, over and above any  
expenses incurred by him when attending meetings or conventions on  
behalf of the Municipality held outside the City of North Bay.
2. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and effect on the first day  
of January 1952.
3. THAT all By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law are hereby repealed.


READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 7TH DAY OF APRIL 1952.
