

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 180-87

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 89-81
BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF
VOTING RECORDERS AND A VOTING RECORDER
SYSTEM AT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE CITY
OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay
deems it desirable to discontinue the use of a voting recorder
system at municipal elections in the City of North Bay.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH
BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 89-81 of The Corporation of the City
of North Bay is hereby repealed.
2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send forthwith a
certified copy of this by-law to the Minister of
Municipal Affairs.
