

BY-LAW NUMBER 966

Being a By-Law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close part of a certain street and lanes within the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay has been requested, and upon consideration, deems it advisable to close a part of Kehoe Street between Rose Avenue and High Street in the City of North Bay together with the lanes between the various lots abutting on or adjacent to that part of Kehoe Street above mentioned, and to convey that portion of Kehoe Street and the several lanes upon their being closed up, to the Right Reverend David J. Scollard, of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing, Bishop of the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie.

THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act, being R. S. O. 1927, Chapter 233, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT that part of Kehoe Street lying between the extended Southerly limit of Rose Avenue and the extended Northerly limit of High Street together with all those lanes between the various lots bounded on the North by the Southerly limit of Rose Avenue, on the East by the Westerly limit of O'Brien Street, on the South by the Northerly limit of High Street and on the West by the Easterly limit of McLeod Street, as the said Street and lanes are shown on a plan of subdivision of the City of North Bay entered in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay as Plan M-175 and which said street and lanes are more particularly described in Schedule "A" which is attached to and forms a part of this By-Law, be and the same are hereby closed and stopped up.

2. THAT forthwith upon this By-law taking effect the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay

shall convey that portion of Kehoe Street and the lanes closed and stopped up under the next preceding section to the Right Reverend David J. Scollard, of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing, Bishop of the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie, for the consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).

3. THAT the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her Solicitor, counsel, or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this By-Law, and who applies to be heard.

4. THAT this By-law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Statutes in that behalf.

SCHEDULE "A"

966 THIS is Schedule "A" referred to in By-Law Number attached hereto, being a description of the street and lanes referred to in Section One (1) of By-Law Number .

All and Singular those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises, lying and being in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing and Province of Ontario and being composed of,--

FIRSTLY:- That portion of Kehoe Street lying South of the extended Southerly limit of Rose Avenue and North of the extended Northerly limit of High Street in the City of North Bay as the same is shown tinted red on a blue print of plan M-175 prepared by G. P. Angus, O.L.S., attached hereto.

AND SECONDLY:- That lane lying along the Southerly limit of Lots Numbers 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25, and Lots Numbers 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157 and 158 on the South Side of Rose Avenue as the same is shown tinted red on a blue print of plan M-175 prepared by G. P. Angus, O.L.S., attached hereto.

AND THIRDLY:- That lane lying along the Northerly limit of Lots Numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, and Lots Numbers 177, 178, 179, 180, 181, 182, 183 and 184 on the North Side of High Street as the same is shown tinted red on a blue print of plan M-175 prepared by G. P. Angus, O.L.S., attached hereto.

AND FOURTHLY:- That lane lying between Lots Numbers 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 on the East Side of McLeod Street and Lots Numbers 34, 33, 32, 31, 30, 29, 28, 27 and 26 on the West Side of Kehoe Street herein stopped up respectively as the same is shown tinted red on a blue print of plan M-175 prepared by G. P. Angus, O.L.S., attached hereto.

AND FIFTHLY:- That lane lying between Lots Numbers 159, 160, 161, 162, 163, 164, 165, 166 and 167 on the East Side of Kehoe

Street herein stopped up and Lots Numbers 168, 169, 170, 171, 172, 173, 174, 175 and 176 on the West Side of O'Brien Street respectively as the same is shown tinted red on a blue print of plan M-175 prepared by G. P. Angus, O.L.S., attached hereto.
