## BY-LAW NUMBER 881.

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 875 which regulates the Sale of Milk, Buttermilk or Cream in the City of North Bay, in certain particulars.

WHEREAS the Provincial Department of Agriculture has recommended certain minor changes in By-law No. 875, which was submitted for approval.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 875 as recommended.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED THAT BY-LAW NO. 875 REGULATING THE SALE OF MILK, BUTTERMILK OR CREAM BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT clause (f) of Section 2 be amended by striking out of the first line the words "house sparate from the other buildings" and insert in lieu thereof the word "room".
- 2. THAT the first and second lines of section 5 be struck out and a new paragraph inserted in lieu thereof, to read as follows:

"Certified milk which must comply with the following standard shall not require to be pasteurized, and it will be unlawful to apply the name certified milk to any milk which does not comply to this standard."

3. THAT Section 6 be amended by inserting after the word "cream" in the first line, the words ", but not including certified milk or cream,".

Read a first time in Open Council this 7th day of May, 1928.

Read a second time in Open Council this 7th day of May, 1928.

Rules of Order were suspended and Dy-law was read a third time short and passed this 7th day of May, 1928.
