

BY-LAW NO. 1890:

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to authorize the construction of additions to the Pinewood Public School and the Dr. MacDougall Public School by the North Bay Public School Board.

WHEREAS it is expedient to construct an additional four (4) classrooms to the Pinewood Public School and an additional four (4) classrooms and one (1) playroom to the Dr. MacDougall Public School, and

WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the construction of the said additions to the Pinewood and Dr. MacDougall Public Schools the sum of \$240,000.00.


THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS

FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the North Bay Public School Board be given authority to construct such new additions of four (4) classrooms to the Pinewood Public School and four (4) classrooms and playroom to the Dr. MacDougall Public School subject to approval by the North Bay City Council by resolution.
2. THAT the North Bay Public School Board shall forthwith make such plans and specifications as may be necessary for the calling of tenders, and for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the supervision and according to the direction of the North Bay Public School Board, or its architect.
4. THAT the Treasurer of the City of North Bay may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction pending completion of such construction.
5. THAT THE debentures to be issued for the loan to be affected to pay for the cost of this work, shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and the debenture principal and the debenture interest be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan as approved by the Department of Education, and under authority of the Public Schools Act, being Chapter 316, Section 56, R.S.O. 1950, or as amended.
6. THAT this By-law shall only become effective on the final passing after approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board by virtue of Section 67, Ontario Municipal Board Act, Chapter 262, R.S.O. 1950.

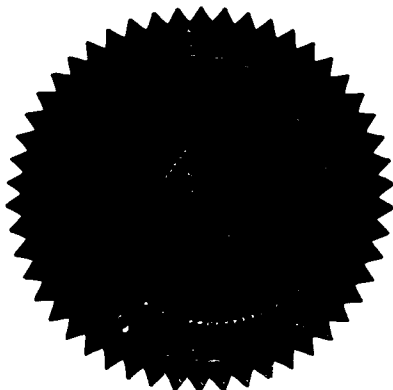

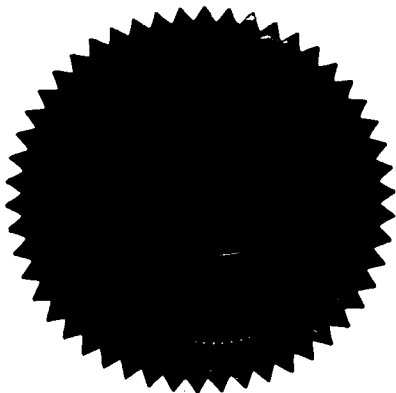
