BY-LAW NO. 2002-42

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 135-92
BEING A BY-LAW FOR ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING
A SYSTEM FOR THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL AND
APPROPRIATE DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES AND
RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay is the owner and operator of the Merrick Township Sanitary Landfill site;

AND WHEREAS the City is authorized to enact by-laws for establishing and maintaining a system for the collection, removal and disposal of garbage and other refuse pursuant to Section 208.2 of the Municipal Act, **R.S.O.**1990, Chapter M-45;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to reduce the level of service for waste collection for residential, single unit dwellings from 4 bags/containers to 3 bags/containers per week and the level of service for the industrial, commercial and institutional section from 8 bags/containers to 6 bags/containers twice a week; and that the City ban the use of corrugated cardboard boxes as a type of waste receptacle in all areas of the City, except in the Downtown Improvement Area;

AND WHEREAS the Council passed Resolution No. 2002-174, adopting Engineering and Works Committee Report No. 2002-03, Clause No. 1, at its meeting held Monday, April 8,2002;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That Clause No. 4 of the Solid Waste Management By-law No. 135-92 be hereby amended by adding the following to subsection (1):
 - (3) That corrugated cardboard boxes not be a permitted receptacle except in the Downtown Improvement Area.
2. That Clauses No. 2(a) and 2(b) be amended by deleting the clauses contained therein and inserting in lieu thereof the following Clauses No. 2(a) and 2(b):
 - (a) The total number of containers placed at curbside for the collection of solid waste shall not exceed three (3) per week from each self-contained dwelling unit.
 - (b) The total number of containers placed at curbside for the collection of solid waste from non-residential premises shall not exceed 6 containers twice per week.
3. That this by-law comes into force and effect July 1,2002.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 6TH DAY OF MAY, 2002.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 6TH DAY OF MAY, 2002.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 6TH DAY OF MAY, 2002.
