

BY-LAW NUMBER 644

BEING a By-law to authorize the levying of a rate of Taxation for the Town of North Bay, to meet the requirements for the year 1922.

WHEREAS it is necessary that a sufficient amount of money be raised by taxation, to meet the necessary expenses of the Town of North Bay, for the year 1922.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, as follows:-

1. THAT a rate of 18.9 mills on the dollar for general purposes be levied on all taxable property of the Municipality of the said Town of North Bay as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1922 as finally revised and passed.
2. THAT a rate of 4.6 mills on the dollar for Collegiate Institute purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the Municipality for the said Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1922, as finally revised and passed.
3. THAT a rate of 15 mills on the dollar for Public School purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the Public School supporters in the Municipality of the said Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1922, as finally revised and passed.
4. THAT a rate of 15 mills on the dollar for Separate School purposes be levied on all the taxable property of the Separate School supporters in the Municipality of the Town of North Bay, as per the Assessment Roll for the year 1922 as finally revised and passed.

Read a second time in open Council March 6th., 1922.
