## BY LAW NUMBER 843.

BEING a By-Law to appoint a Sanitary and Plumbing Inspector, and Milk Inspector and Relief Officer for the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed adviseable to appoint an official for the City of North Bay, to be known as the Sanitary and Plumbing Inspector, Milk Inspector and Relief Officer.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE hereby enacted by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay as follows:

1. THAT Alfred Tandy be and is hereby appointed Sanitary and Plumbing Inspector, Milk Inspector and Relief Officer for the City of North Bay at an annual salary of "Seventeen Hundred Dollars" (\$1700.00), payable at the rate of "One Hundred and Forty-one Dollars and Sixty-six and twothirds cents (\$141.662/3) per month.

2. THAT the said Inspector will devote his entire time to the service of the City of North Bay, and thoroughly and promptly perform and execute all matters and duties usually attended to by the Sanitary Inspector. He will also inspect the plumbing in all buildings now in the course of erection or hereafter to be erected within the limits of the City, such inspection to be made while the building is in course of construction, and he is not to permit any building to be completed until all plumbing therein has been made to his entire satisfaction.

THIS By-Law to take effect from April 1st, 1927.
