BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay authorizing the construction of a proposed extension to the Collegiate Institute and Vocational School by the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board.

WHEREAS it is expedient to construct six (6) additional rooms as an extension to The Collegiate Institute and Vocational School.

WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the construction of this proposed addition to The Collegiate Institute and Vocational School the sum of One Hundred and Twonty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00). Forty-One \$141,000.00

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board be given authority to construct six additional rooms to The Collegiate Institute and Vocational School, subject to approval by the North Bay City Council by Resolution.
- 2. That the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board shall forthwith make such plans and specifications as may be necessary for the calling of tenders and for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- 3. That the work shall be carried on and executed under the supervision and according to the directions of the North Bay Collegiate and Vocational School Board or its architect.
- 4. That the Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction pending the completion of it.
- 5. That the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of this work shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and the Debenture Principal and Debenture Interest be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan as approved by the Department of Education.
- 6. That this By-law shall only become effective on final passing after approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board by virtue of Section 67, Ontario Municipal Board Act, Chapter 262, R.S.O. 1950.


