BEING a By-Law to amend By-Law Number 568.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend By-Law Number 568, governing the running of cattle at large within the Town of North Bay.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Section Number 2 of By-Law Number 568 be repealed and the following substituted:

(A) No person shall keep a horse, bull, ox, cow, sheep, goat, pig or other cattle, geese, chickens or other poultry, on any property within the Town of North Bay, unless said property is enclosed by a proper fence.

(B) No person shall permit or allow any horse, bull, ox, cow, sheep, goat, pig or other cattle, to be tethered on any land within the limits of the Town of North Bay, unless such land is fenced in on all sides to protect adjoining property.

READ a second time in Open Council this 17th day of December, 1923.

Rules of order suspended and By-Law read a third time short and passed, this 17th day of December, 1923.
