BY-LAW NO. 81-71

BEING A BY-LAW TO RATIFY AND CONFIRM THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY FOR PURPOSES OF THE CORPORATION.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay has authorized the acquisition of the lands hereinafter described at the price hereinafter set forth for the purposes of the Corporation;
