## BY-LAW NO. 1810

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1456.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 1456.

BY-LAW No. 1456 is amended and the following shall be enacted.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule (b) Paragraph 7 of By-law No. 1456 be amended and the following added thereto:

Excepting thereto and therefrom that part described as follows: ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing, and being composed of all of Lot #379, according to a plan of subdivision filed in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing as Plan No. 21.

2. THAT Schedule "D" be amended to add the area described as follows:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing, and being composed of all of Lot #379, according to a plan of sub-division filed in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing as Plan No. 21.

3. This By-law shall come into effect upon its approval by the Ontario Municipal Board.
