

BY-LAW NO. 1600

BEING a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 1200 a By-Law regulating the Transient Traders in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend Clause No. 1 of By-Law No. 1200.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Clause No. 1 of By-Law No. 1200 be amended by deleting "the sum of One Hundred Dollars" and the figures "\$100.00" which appear in the last line of the said Clause, and that these words and figures be substituted with the following: " the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), so that Clause No. 1 of By-Law No. 1200 as amended will now read:


Clause No. 1. There shall be taken out by every Transient Trader or other person in the City of North Bay whose name has not been entered on the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality in respect of *at. ph.* ~~income or~~ business assessment for the then current year and who may offer goods ,wares or merchandise of any description for sale by auction conducted by himself or by a licensed auctioneer or otherwise, or who offers them for sale in any other manner, a license authorizing him to carry on his trade or calling within the limits of the said City, and for which license the person obtaining same shall pay at the time of the issue of such license the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

2. This By-Law shall take effect immediately after the passing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 20th DAY OF NOVEMBER 1950.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 20th DAY OF NOVEMBER 1950.
