

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 150-88

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE SHERBROOKE STREET BETWEEN OAK STREET AND MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS Section 208 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Sub-Section 43, authorizes the Council to pass By-Laws to temporarily close any highway or portion of a highway during the construction, repairing or improvement of such highway.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That part of Sherbrooke Street between Oak Street and Main Street in the City of North Bay is hereby closed from 1 November 1988 to 30 November 1988 for the purpose of installing a storm sewer.
2. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1988.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER 1988.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1988.
