BY-LAW NO. 1671

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend By-Law No. 1667, a by-law for the Revision of Salaries in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that By-Law No. 1667 be amended. THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 243 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ONTARIO AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS.

1. THAT clause No. 1 of By-Law No. 1667 be amended by deleting the word 'regular' from the 5th and 6th lines, so that the Clause will now read:

"THAT each duly elected Alderman of the City of North Bay shall be paid the annual remuneration of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) which said sum shall be payable quarterly. Provided however that there shall be a deduction of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) from each Alderman for each meeting of Council not attended by him and a further deduction of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each Committee Meeting not attended."
